1927 ship plans

Subseries consists of two files: one containing the original 1927 ship plans for the *St. Roch* that were drawn by Thomas Halliday, and another containing various copies of the 1927 ship plans. Each plan comprises of one or more technical drawings on one sheet. While Halliday and Burrard Drydock Co. Ltd. are the original creators of the 1927 plans, the copy creator and copy date of each copied plan is unknown.

Original 1927 ship plans (5 records)

File contains the original 1927 ship plans of *St. Roch* drawn by Thomas Halliday and created by Burrard Drydock, Co. Ltd. of North Vancouver. The vessel was contracted by the federal government and was launched on May 7, 1928.

Each plan comprises of one or more technical drawings on one sheet. The plans include: a lines plan, midship section, structural arrangement, rigging plan, and general arrangement.

File contains copies of the 1927 ship plans of the *St. Roch*. Each plan comprises of one or more technical drawings on one sheet. Among the copies are plans of the vessel's lines; structural arrangement; general arrangement; rigging; general arrangement; fastenings arrangement; midship section; and rudder and stern section. There are multiple copies of some plans. The copy date and copy creator for each plan is unknown.

1940s ship plans (6 records)

File consists of ship plans from the 1940s for the *St. Roch*. In 1944 the vessel was reconfigured to include a larger deckhouse and a more powerful engine. These enhancements were made in Halifax, Nova Scotia before the *St. Roch* started the trip back to Vancouver on July 26, 1944. Each plan comprises of one or more technical drawings on one sheet. In addition to plans of the new deckhouse and general arrangement, a 1942 diagram of the radio transmitter connections is also included.

1958 ship plans (5 records)

File consists of 1958 ship plans of the *St. Roch* from when the vessel was being restored to it's 1928 configuration by Vancouver Shipyards, which included the removal of the 1944 deckhouse. The same year the *St. Roch* was hauled out in Vancouver and in 1959, construction of the Vancouver Maritime Museum was completed beside the vessel.

Each plan comprises of one or more technical drawings on one sheet. Plans include those of the haul out arrangement, ground cradling, awning arrangement, and a section of the engine room.

1969 ship plans (65 records)

The DIAND, overseeing Parks Canada at the time, was in charge of the *St. Roch* refurbishment after the construction of the A-frame (1966) and therefore had the most complete plans of the vessel. In 1958, the City of Vancouver removed the deckhouse and restored the *St. Roch* to her 1928 configuration. In 1971, Canada Parks Service started a restoration project to return the *St. Roch* to her 1944 appearance, including a complete reconstruction of the deckhouse, as well as the replacement of some timbers and deck. Likely these plans were used for the reconstruction.

File consists of plans that appear to all have been drawn by 4 separate naval architects in the span of a few months. Drawings are numbered 2 - 56, with some missing numbers. Each plan consists of one or more technical drawings on one sheet and include copies of the original 1927 ship plans of the *St. Roch*.
