ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY / BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

The journal *Harbour & Shipping* began in 1918 with William Norman Code, one of the original partners and Murray McLellan's grandfather. Norman, as he was known, married Mary Alma Burrows in 1914. Together they had a daughter Wilma Janet Code.

The other original partner of *Harbour & Shipping* magazine was James H. (Jimmy) Hamilton who was also on the 1921 organizing committee of the original Vancouver Merchant's Exchange. He was also the first manager of the Exchange, the predecessor of the current Chamber of Shipping of British Columbia.

Hamilton retired in 1945 and Code continued on as publisher until 1958 when he sold the business to his son-in-law, Norman (Mac) McLellan. Norman McLellan married Wilma Code in 1940. McLellan had been editor since returning from WWII in 1946 where he had been a Canadian naval officer with the British Navy.

In 1963 Norman's son Murray McLellan left UBC and began working for his father selling advertising for the magazine. He also began taking pictures and quickly became one of the top professional marine photographers in Vancouver.

Norman McLellan died in 1972 and Murray took control of the magazine. His daughter, Kristin Hodge, joined him as editor and later assistant to the publisher. She was in charge of marketing, public relations and assisted the editor Allison Smith with special projects.

Harbour & Shipping ceased publishing in 2010. Murray McLellan passed away in 2016.
